



Ordinance No. 31-09 : An Ordinance Lifting the City of West Lafayette's Restrictions on the Import of Certain Types of Waste Generated Outside the Corporate Limits of the City of West Lafayette.

Background Information

Our new digesters at the wastewater treatment plant were designed to take hauled wastes in the form of Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) in order to produce more biogas for fueling the microturbines.

Our digesters have capacity for these hauled wastes. They have a great deal of capacity.

Part of the original project was to charge a tipping fee for FOG that is delivered to the plant. The FOG program will benefit us in two ways: tipping fees and more "green" electricity.

For housekeeping purposes, we need to clean up the language in the Sewer Use Ordinance.
