

ORDINANCE NO. 32-09

**AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION
CLERK'S RECORD PERPETUATION FUND**

WHEREAS, the Clerk's Record Perpetuation Fund was established pursuant to IC 33-37-5-2 for the purpose of funding the preservation of records and the improvement of record keeping systems and equipment; and

WHEREAS, document storage fees assessed for West Lafayette City Court cases as required under IC 33-37-5-20 have been deposited into the Clerk's record Perpetuation Fund; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of e-tickets by the West Lafayette Police Department has necessitated programming services to enable automatic file uploads into the City Court database system, and these costs are properly funded by the Clerk's Record Perpetuation Fund.

SECTION 1.

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Tippecanoe County, Indiana, that for the expenses of the municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws of governing the same:

CLERK'S RECORD PERPETUATION FUND

Account 5-394, Contract Services	\$6,000.00
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SECTION 2.

Explanation for the additional appropriation:

This fund must be appropriated to reimburse the Cumulative Capital Development Fund for expenses of programming changes to enable automatic e-ticket file uploads to City Court.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and signing by the Mayor, and notification of the additional appropriation to the Department of Local Government Finance.
