

**ORDINANCE NO. 2-10 (Amended)**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR FIRE PENSION FUND and TRANSFER FOR POLICE PENSION FUND**

WHEREAS, the 2009 Fire Pension appropriation was insufficient to pay obligations due by statute for pension benefits due on December 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Pension Secretary and Clerk-Treasurer did authorize payment of these pension benefits through the West Lafayette Board of Public Works and Safety and now request Common Council approval to increase the necessary appropriation effective December 15, 2009; and

**WHEREAS, the Police Pension appropriation requires reallocation for personal (100 category) expenditure obligations;**

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Tippecanoe County, Indiana, that for the expenses of the municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated **effective December 15, 2009** and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws of governing the same:

**Explanation for the additional appropriation and transfer:**

The proper officers of the City shall appropriate funds in such a manner that the expenditures for the year do not exceed the budget for the year. The State Board of Accounts will accept action of the Common Council to retroactively authorize the additional appropriation prior to commencement of the fiscal year audit.
