**SUBJECT: Salt Sales to Other Governmental Units**

**DATE: March 5, 2010**

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On September 23, 2008 the Board of Works approved the sale of 50 to 100 tons of salt to the Town of Shadeland for the 2008-2009 winter season at our cost. This was a one-time arrangement. In December 2008, Shadeland purchased 16.9 tons of salt and in January 2009, another 50.94 tons of salt. The price per ton was \$61.84 for a total cost of \$4,195.23.

On January 29, 2010, Shadeland made a payment to the City for salt purchases in the amount of \$5,198.06. Shadeland was paying invoices from the Street Department for 29.69 tons of salt on December 8, 2009 and 50.90 tons of salt on January 12, 2010. The price was \$64.50 per ton for a total cost of \$5,198.06.

The Board of Works must approve the sale of City salt supplies to other governmental units.
