PRE-COUNCIL MINUTES
FEBRUARY 25, 2010

The Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, met in the Lower Level Conference Room at City Hall on February 25, 2010, at the hour of 4:30 p.m.

Mayor Dennis called the meeting to order and presided.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Ordinance No. 28-09 An Ordinance Amending The General Provisions And Service Charges For Refuse And Garbage Collection In The City Of West Lafayette (Submitted by Councilor Bunder)

Mayor Dennis read Ordinance No. 28-09 by title.

Councilor Bunder moved to amend Ordinance No. 28-09 by substitution. Councilor Burch seconded the motion.

Councilor Bunder said the amended version is a lot different than the ordinance passed on first reading.

Councilor Hunt moved to amend the amended ordinance offered by Councilor Bunder, requesting that, on page 2, section 67.06 (a), reference to a 48-gallon container be changed to a 50-gallon container, as 48-gallon containers are not available commercially in the community. The motion was seconded by Councilor Hoggatt. There was no discussion.

The amendment to the amended ordinance passed unanimously by voice vote of the members present.

Councilor Hunt reported that the amended document offered for substitution is the result of a lot of work by many people, and she thanked those who worked on the committee. Mayor Dennis added his thanks.

The motion to pass the amended ordinance by substitution was unanimous by voice vote of the members present.
