The Village Fitness Trail ribbon-cutting took place on August 11th. The 2 1/6-mile, urban trail is intended primarily for walking and is designated with sidewalk markers and trailhead signs at Morton Community Center, Centennial Neighborhood Park, the renovated track at the West Lafayette Junior/Senior High School, and the Municipal Pool behind Happy Hollow School.

A workshop on the use of pervious concrete as a best management practice for stormwater management was held at Lilly Nature Center on August 26th. Through contributions by Irving Materials and Milestone Contractors, the workshop included the installation of seven new parking spaces for the nature center.
