FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chief executive officer, president or vice president of the Company may delegate the authority to enter into contractual commitments which they are authorized to execute pursuant to these resolutions to any other officer, assistant division manager, district manager or branch manager of the Company and may, as requested by any third party, indicate such delegation by addressing a letter or other written document to such third party.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that prior to execution thereof pursuant to the preceding resolution, any contract in excess of the authorized limits granted to the President of the Company, must be approved by any two Managers; provided, however, that the execution of any contract in accordance with the preceding resolution may be considered by all third parties to be conclusive evidence that all appropriate authority pursuant to these resolutions has been granted.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the secretary, any assistant secretary, or any other officer of the Company be, and they hereby are, authorized to certify a copy of these resolutions, and any customer of the Company is hereby authorized to rely upon said certificate as so presented.


