RE: March 2012 Monthly Report

During the month of February, the West Lafayette Police Department received **1935 calls for service**, a decrease of 15 calls (1%) from February, and a decrease of 6 calls (0%) from March 2011.

In the last week of March, WLPD Detectives arrested two suspects from Lafayette in connection with the armed robbery of a pizza delivery driver in the 200 block of S. River Rd. on March 15th. The suspects were each charged with one count of Robbery While Armed with a Deadly Weapon and one count of Intimidation. No other suspects are being sought in this case at this time.

The West Lafayette Community School Corporation and the WLPD conducted a critical incident lockdown drill at the Jr/Sr High campus on March 27th. The drill is part of the overall safety plan for the school corporation and the police department.

Officers conducted a RAD class for twelve women at the police station over four evenings in March. RAD classes for women, children and seniors will continue to be offered throughout the year. Please check the department web site for upcoming dates and locations for RAD classes.

DARE Officer Janet Shepherd conducted two drug drop off events this past month, one in conjunction with WLF1 TV18 and the Lafayette Police Department. In all, 270 people dropped off over 745 lbs. of drugs for disposal, enough to fill a donated U-haul truck.
