

NORTH SIDE REGIONAL LIFT STATION AND FORCE MAIN IMPROVEMENTS

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana will receive sealed bids for the **North Side Regional Lift Station and Force Main Improvements** until the hour of **8:30 AM** local time on **August 21, 2012**, at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer, City Hall, 609 West Navajo Street, West Lafayette, Indiana 47906, for the completion of the work hereinafter listed. Bids received after said time will be returned unopened. No oral, telephoned, telegraphed, or facsimile bids or changes to bids will be considered. After said time, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, City Hall, 609 West Navajo Street, West Lafayette, Indiana 47906.

The Work shall generally consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, supplies and services for the construction of a new lift station, standby generator, electrical building, approximately 4,000 feet of 12-inch force main, approximately 6,000 feet of 8-inch force main and all associated Work complete in place as shown and specified.

A **Pre-Bid Conference** will be held on **August 7, 2012** at **1:00 p.m.** local time at the West Lafayette Wastewater Treatment Utility, 500 South River Road, West Lafayette, Indiana 47906. All bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference.

Bids must be entered upon the bid form and the State Form 52414 (R/9-10)/Form 96 (Revised 2010), submitted in **triplicate** with the bid and non-collusion affidavit properly executed, and must comply with the statutes of Indiana and with the rules and regulations of the State Board of Accounts of Indiana. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked, **“BID – NORTH SIDE REGIONAL LIFT STATION AND FORCE MAIN IMPROVEMENTS”**.

The bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid price made in favor of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, which amount shall accrue to and become the property of the City should the Bidder, awarded a contract, fail to enter into the required written agreement and secure the same with the required one hundred percent (100%) performance, payment, and guarantee bond. Wage rates for the work shall be not less than the current Davis-Bacon prescribed wage scale.
