### **Sagamore West Farmers Market Opens May 1**

West Lafayette, Ind.—April 22, 2013—The Sagamore West Farmers Market opens on Wednesday, May 1. The Market is held weekly in Cumberland Park, 3065 N. Salisbury Street, West Lafayette, from 3 to 6:30 pm on Wednesdays through October 30.

This year the Market offers expanded options for dining. Whyte Horse Winery will now be selling wine by the glass, local restaurants and local cooks provide take-out options plus the new Patio allows shoppers to sit and enjoy a meal at the Market. Prepared food vendors include the EMT food truck, bringing their Nutty Monkey; The Parthenon, offering tasty Greek foods; Adelino's, cooking up a variety of kebabs and Cleaver Family Farms, grilling pork and beef burgers.
