This AMENDMENT NO. 2 is made on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 2014 to modify AMENDMENT NO. 1 to the AGREEMENT dated June 18, 2013 and the AGREEMENT dated December 18, 2012 between the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, hereinafter referred to as CITY, and Greeley and Hansen LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, with its principal office at 100 South Wacker Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60606-4003, and a regional office at 7820 Innovation Boulevard, Suite 150, Indianapolis, Indiana 46278, hereinafter referred to as ENGINEER, for professional engineering services in connection with the Cumberland Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension, the PROJECT.

This AGREEMENT is hereby amended as follows:

**SCOPE OF SERVICES**

The scope of services shall be expanded to include Engineering Services as described in Exhibit A2 – Scope of Basic Construction Administration Services for Cumberland Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension, attached as part of this AMENDMENT No. 2.

**COMPENSATION**


The estimated compensation as described in Exhibit B2 – Level of Effort and Estimated Compensation for engineering services described in Exhibit A2, attached as part of this AMENDMENT No. 2 shall not exceed \$84,562, including salary and reimbursable expenses, without further written authorization. With the approval of AMENDMENT No. 2, the total upper limit of compensation for the AGREEMENT is increased from \$227,165 to \$311,727.

**OTHER MATTERS**

All provisions of the Contract not specifically modified herein shall remain in effect.



## EXHIBIT A2

AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES  
between  
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### SCOPE OF BASIC CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR CUMBERLAND AVENUE SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION

The scope of basic construction administration services under this Amendment No. 2 comprises the following tasks for the Cumberland Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension Project:

#### TASK 5 CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES

5.1 Shop Drawings. Review up to 10 shop drawings and/or product submittals for compliance with the design intent as expressed in the Contract Documents.

Costs associated with review of third and subsequent submittals shall be invoiced separately from the other tasks. Costs associated with review of third or subsequent submittals are not included in the compensation set forth in this Agreement for Professional Engineering Services and shall be compensated for as additional services.

5.2 Site Visits. Qualified representatives of the Engineer shall visit the site at approximately monthly intervals during construction. Any comments and observations regarding the construction work shall be given to the Resident Engineer and OWNER.

5.3 Supplementary Drawings. Prepare supplementary detailed drawings and specifications as needed for clarification of the Contract Drawings. Design changes are excluded from the scope of this task and will be provided upon separate authorization by OWNER.

5.4 Contractor's Claims. Review Contractor's claims and provide recommendations to OWNER for disposition for up to 6 claims.

5.5 General Administration. Respond to inquiries from the Resident Engineer, Contractor and OWNER relative to interpretation of the drawings and specifications, project schedule, pay applications, change orders and other matters concerning construction. Scope is based upon providing responses for up to 10 Contractor requests for information (RFIs).

5.6 Record Drawings. Revise the original contract drawings to reference changes reported to the Resident Engineer during construction. These record drawings shall incorporate changes shown on the Contractor's and the Resident Engineer's record sets of drawings, supplementary drawings, shop drawings, and other records of field changes. Provide the OWNER with record drawings consisting of two full-size printed sets and two copies of electronic AutoCAD files.
