RE: June 2014

Call totals: West Lafayette Fire responded to 85 Total Calls in June: 63 Medical, 3 Fire, 5 Hazardous Condition, 6 Service Calls, 4 Good-Intent Calls, and 4 False Alarms. Year-to-date incidents is 970. On June 19, an excavator working on the 225 Northwestern project cut the brand new gas main. Fortunately, our men did not have far to go since it was right outside Station 1.

Training: A-Shift kicked off the month of June with a training session on portable ladder skills at City Hall followed by a review of elevator rescue operation presented by Jeff Need. A-Shift practiced hose stretching and standpipe skills at the West Lafayette Public Library parking garage and reviewed pumping operations/hydrant connections. All this plus active shooter training and EMS in-service brought A-Shift's total to 151 man hours of training in June. B-Shift had a fairly busy month with over 150 man hours of training. B-Shift completed the EVOC (Emergency Vehicle Operator Course) as well as a tour of Chauncey Square, Connection Point Church, and the Med Institute. B-Shift finished up the last thirty day period with active shooter training with WLPD. C-Shift had 212.5 man hours of training in June, including a building tour of the Med Institute, individual medical and fire skills, Ladder 2 operation and driving, medical in-service, active shooter training with WLPD, a class on VEIS (Vent Enter Isolate Search), and physical Fitness. C-Shift also installed Storz fittings on hydrants throughout the city, bringing their year-to-date total to 1,298 man hours.

ARFF Training: On June 17, we signed a Memorandum of Agreement to do AARF (Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting) Training with Grissom Air Reserve Base. This training will prepare the WLPD to respond to an aircraft emergency in the event a plane does not make it to the airport. It also prepares us to assist the Purdue University Fire Department at the airport. Purdue is already the second busiest airport in the state and with the new GE plant, air traffic over our cities will likely increase. Grissom will provide us a 40 hour ARFF training class that will culminate with live fire training at Grissom.
