RE: March 2015 Monthly Report

During the month of March the West Lafayette Police Department received **2,476 calls for service**, a decrease of 77 calls (3%) from February, and an increase of 266 calls (12%) from March 2014.

This spring, the WLPD once again joined 250 other Indiana law enforcement agencies in the "Drunk Driving – Over the Limit – Under Arrest" campaign as part of Operation Pull Over, a statewide enforcement effort supported by the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute.

In March, WLPD officers worked 100 extra hours of traffic enforcement focusing on seatbelt compliance and impaired driving, netting 13 arrests for Operating While Intoxicated. In April, officers will continue their extra hours of traffic enforcement to include a sobriety checkpoint during Grand Prix week to promote "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over".

As the weather warms this month, officers will be busy with several safety initiatives aimed at promoting pedestrian safety and bicycle safety. WLPD officers will be on bicycle patrols with Purdue University Police in the Village and Campus areas starting this week.
