Projects:

- Cumberland Ave. Reconstruction, Ph. 3: Milestone Contractors has completed the majority of the construction work on the project. The road was opened to all traffic on August 6th. The contractor is in the process of completing lighting and signal work on the contract. A separate landscaping project has been awarded to Custom Cuts. This project will add plants and shrubs along the median of the new section of road as well as add trees along the outside edge of the road. Work started the end of September and should be complete in late October.
- Happy Hollow Road Reconstruction: The contractor has opened Happy Hollow Road at the intersection of River Road after a complete reconstruction. This was followed by the closure of North Bound Happy Hollow to begin the reconstruction of the north side of the road. The contract completion is set for October 2016.
- Northwestern Ave. Safety Improvements, Ph. 4: This project includes safety improvements on Northwestern Avenue from Cherry Lane to Dodge Street and from Grant Street to North Street.

Work is complete for the construction of new curb, sidewalk, and approaches between Grant Street and North Street and at the intersection of Cherry Lane. Lighting and signal work is currently schedule to begin as materials are delivered. All work should be complete by the end of October.

- Lindberg Road Reconstruction: Lindberg Road is currently in the preliminary design phase.
- 5th and 6th Street Project: This project is the reconstruction of curb and sidewalk along 5th and 6th Streets between University and Russell. The contractor completed this work in early August.
- Cattail Trail: This is a new trail extension that is under construction tying in the existing trail at Yeager Road and Northwestern Avenue to the existing trail at Cumberland Avenue and Sagamore Parkway. This contract is now complete.
