Our leaf collection schedule begins next week! Please check the attached schedule for the dates we will be in your area with the leaf vacs. The leaf vacs may come to your area additional times throughout the season if time allows, but the only time that it is guaranteed is during the posted schedule. We recommend having your leaves out by the first day of the scheduled week to avoid getting missed. Consider piling your leaves between the curb and sidewalk instead of in the bike lanes to keep our city streets safe for bicyclists.




All leaves are to be raked 12 inches away from the curb line in a windrow. Please keep catch basins free of leaves. **Do not place sticks or other debris in with the leaves.**

Please have your leaves raked out by the first day of the posted time to avoid missed pick up. We will also pick up leaves in rigid containers on your scheduled yard waste pick up day.



While you are cleaning up your yard, please ensure that your trees and shrubs are not causing an obstruction for pedestrians or vehicles. Tree branches should be at least 8 feet above the sidewalk and 15 feet above the street. Your assistance with trimming the trees and shrubs would be greatly appreciated.
