

WEST LAFAYETTE POLICE MERIT COMMISSION MINUTES

The West Lafayette Police Merit Commission met in regular session in the West Lafayette Police Department Conference Room at the West Lafayette Police Department on November 9, 2015 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Commission President Shafer, Commission Vice President Corrigan, Commissioner Troyer and Commissioner Kirkpatrick

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Commission President Shafer called the meeting to order. President Shafer asked for a motion to approve the minutes for the October meeting. Commissioner Troyer moved that the minutes be approved. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Corrigan. The motion was passed by unanimous voice vote.

OLD BUSINESS:

Deputy Chief Leroux asked that the Commission remove an applicant from the hiring process due to results related to the background investigation. NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Kirkpatrick was requesting updates on the budget from time to time. Commission President Shafer and Deputy Chief Leroux will come up with a mechanism to make that happen.

Commission President Shafer brought up for discussion, which can be further discussed at the December meeting, the amount of paperwork generated for the interview process that is given to the Merit Commission for review. Commission President Shafer will send an email to the commission with the categories within the packet on what the commission should exclude in the future.

Commissioner Troyer wanted the merit board to thank Deputy Chief Leroux for all his meritorious service to the merit commission, the community and the police department

and wish him the best in his retirement. Deputy Chief Leroux expressed his thanks and appreciation. Commissioner Kirkpatrick asked how the new Deputy Chief is chosen with Deputy Chief Leroux telling her that the Mayor appoints the new Deputy Chief. The person the mayor has chosen is Capt. Troy Harris.

CHIEF'S REPORT:


No Chief's Report this month.
