47	55	<i>400 series - Hazardous Condition (No Fire)</i> includes gasoline spills, natural gas leaks, and other hazards not resulting in a fire
110	92	<i>500 series - Service Call</i> includes lifting assistance, unauthorized burning, and other service calls
64	84	<i>600 series - Good Intent Call</i> includes canceled en route, steam mistaken for smoke and other calls made with good intent
151	166	<i>700 series - False Alarm and False Call</i> includes malfunctioning alarm systems or maliciously or mischievously activated ones
