

## RESOLUTION NO. 14-08

### A RESOLUTION TO REDUCE THE 2008 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2008 budget appropriations as approved by the Common Council and authorized in the 2008 Budget Order from the Department of Local Government Finance are in excess of expenditures currently anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of the Fiscal Year 2008 budget will enable these funds to be available for appropriation for the Fiscal Year 2009 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The 2008 budget appropriations are reduced as follows:
