RE: February 2013 Monthly Report


During the month of February, the West Lafayette Police Department received **2403 calls for service**, an increase of 508 calls (27%) from January, and an increase of 453 calls (23%) from February 2012.

A routine traffic stop by WLPD patrol officers in early February led to the arrest of four subjects from Monticello on various methamphetamine related felony charges, including manufacturing meth and possession of anhydrous ammonia, a dangerous chemical used to manufacture meth. During the traffic stop, a WLPD drug detection K-9 unit alerted to the presence of narcotics inside the vehicle.

On February 14th, WLPD detectives under the direction of Lt. Troy Harris, arrested two suspects for the daytime armed robbery of the West Lafayette Check Into Cash store that occurred in October 2012. The lengthy investigation included the processing of DNA evidence. WLPD detectives worked with the Marion and the Indianapolis Metro Police Departments over the course of several months to locate the suspects and to close this case.

WLPD Officers Janet Winslow and Nancee Hetrick participated in the Cumberland School Winter Carnival this past month where they finger printed 75 children while speaking with them about safety related topics.
