RE: March 2014 Monthly Report

During the month of March, the West Lafayette Police Department received **2,210 calls for service**, a decrease of 177 calls (7%) from February, and a decrease of 23 calls (1%) from March 2013.

During the first week of March, Crisis Intervention Team training, sponsored by the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), was coordinated and presented by WLPD Officer Jeff Decker. Officers from around the region participated in the certified training program. Three additional WLPD officers received the Crisis Intervention Team training this past month.

Diligent police work by Officer Adam Ferguson and Sgt. Kevin Flynn this past month led to the arrest of a suspect on felony charges of Auto Theft and Drug Dealing. Officers initially responded to a domestic disturbance call and discovered a stolen vehicle and evidence of a drug dealing operation after conducting a thorough investigation.

Captain John Walker retired from the WLPD in March after 20 years of service. Captain Walker, an officer in the Indiana National Guard, had been on military leave from the department since 2009. We thank Cpt. Walker for his service to the City of West Lafayette and we wish him well in his future endeavors.
