Art on the Wabash, a local artists' fair in Tapawingo Park, was held September 16, 10 am to 4 pm. Select artists from the Tippecanoe Arts Federation's 14-county service area displayed and sold their works of art. The event was enjoyed by hundreds of people.

The West Lafayette Farmers Market is open every Wednesday in Cumberland Park, with fall hours of 4:00 – 7:00 pm.

On Saturday, October 18th from 10:00 am – 1:00 pm, the Morton Community Center, in conjunction with the West Lafayette Public Art Team, will be installing a community art project that will "dress up" the chain link fence on the Salisbury side of Morton's parking lot. 30-40 volunteers ranging in age from 4th grade through adult will be working together to attach over 300 pinwheels to the fence in a predetermined pattern. This project has yet to be titled. The installation will be up for a maximum of 1 year or less, depending on the weather's effect on the project.

Morton will join in the Library's Family Fun Day. Morton will have a number of their instructors on hand performing and demonstrating details from their classes. The community will be invited to join in and participate as well! There will also be information tables, a children's craft area, and registration area.
