RE: July 2015 Monthly Report

During the month of July, the West Lafayette Police Department received **1,952 calls for service**, a decrease of 91 calls (4%) from June, and a decrease of 150 calls (7%) from July 2014.

Last week, Officers Adam Ferguson and Travis Morgan apprehended a suspect that fled on foot from a vehicle traffic stop. Subsequent investigation by the officers led to the discovery of two active meth labs, one west and one north of the city. The suspect was arrested on several felony counts relating to the manufacture of methamphetamine. The Purdue Univ. PD, the Tippecanoe County Sheriff's Office and the Indiana State Police Meth Suppression Unit assisted the WLPD with this investigation.

In mid-July, the WLPD hosted a RAD Kids Camp for one week at Burtsfield Gym. Eighty-five children between the ages of 5 and 12 participated in the daily camp, which concluded with a graduation and picnic at week's end. The children were empowered with skills so they can recognize, avoid, resist, and if necessary escape violence or harm in their lives. Officers Janet Winslow and Nancee Hetrick were assisted by several other officers from surrounding agencies in putting on this well attended camp for area children.
