RE: November 2015 Monthly Report


During the month of November, the West Lafayette Police Department received **2,287 calls for service**, a decrease of 87 calls (4%) from October, and a decrease of 24 calls (1%) from November 2014.

November was a transition month for the department with Deputy Chief Christopher Leroux retiring after 28 years of honorable service. Chris was appointed Deputy Chief of Police in 1998 by Mayor Sonya Margerum and served three mayors in this capacity. Mayor John Dennis appointed Captain Troy Harris to serve as Deputy Chief of Police on November 17th. Additionally, the Police Merit Commission will promote several officers to fill the void in merit ranks at a ceremony after the Board of Works meeting on December 15th.

Last week our detectives arrested two suspects from Lafayette for Armed Robbery relating to a robbery on November 30th at the Williamsburg on the Wabash apartment complex. Detectives worked diligently on this case with officers from Illinois to take these dangerous suspects into custody across state lines without incident.

In November the department joined Nextdoor, a private social network for your neighborhood. Nextdoor is a virtual community watch used by your next door community, including neighborhood associations. The WLPD plans to focus specific crime and safety messages to targeted neighborhoods in the social network.
