

ORDINANCE NO. 13-16

**An Ordinance Requesting An Additional Appropriation And Reduction
To The 2016 Budget**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual 2016 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA, TIPPECANOE COUNTY that:

SECTION 1: For the expenses of the City of West Lafayette, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated out of the funds named and for the purposes specified, subject to laws governing the same:

SECTION 2: Whereas, it has been shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further ordained that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:

\$889-Move balance of Clerk-Treas budget to Finance

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and signing by the Mayor, and approval of the additional appropriation by the Department of Local Government Finance.
