RE: September 2016 Monthly Report

During the month of September, the West Lafayette Police Department received **3,072 calls for service**, an increase of 88 calls (3%) from August, and an increase of 298 calls (11%) from September 2015.

Officers were very busy in September as there were three home Purdue Football games and several weekend festivals and events in town, including Global Fest and Art on the Wabash. The busy weekends in September were safe and few arrests were made in connection to the well-attended events.

Last week, Officer Adam Miller was on patrol for impaired drivers as part of Indiana's Operation Pullover when he stopped a vehicle that was later determined to be stolen. The driver of the stolen vehicle fled on foot and fought with officers after being pulled over. The driver was apprehended by Officers Miller and Bonnell and was arrested and charged with Vehicle Theft, Resisting Law Enforcement, Driving While Suspended, and for being Wanted on Warrant. In addition to this highlighted arrest, officers issued 94 citations (79 for No Seatbelt) and issued 27 warnings while participating in Operation Pullover in September.

The popular monthly Drug Take Back Program took in over 200 lbs. of unwanted prescription and OTC drugs from 35 citizens this past month.
