RE: November 2016 Monthly Report

During the month of November, the West Lafayette Police Department received **2,421 calls for service**, a decrease of 250 calls (9%) from October, and an increase of 134 calls (6%) from November 2015.

The WLPD continued to maintain a high level of visibility to affect safety in the very active roadway construction zones around town as that season nears an end. WLPD Officers recorded 897 traffic stops in November, an increase of over 200 traffic stops from last November with a focus on slowing traffic in those tight construction zones.

One particular traffic stop by Officer Biddle in early November netted the seizure of methamphetamine, syringes and marijuana. Three suspects were arrested and charged with the illegal possession of the seized contraband. The possession of used syringes on suspects is becoming more common and thus, more dangerous for officers in the field.

Officers conducted Rape Aggression Defense (RAD) training from 25 women at the St. Thomas Aquinas Center, November 14 - 28. Additional RAD training classes will be offered to the public in early 2017.
