

**ORDINANCE NO. 31-04 (AMENDED)
AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE TAX LEVY ON PROPERTY
AND TAX RATE FOR THE 2005 CITY BUDGET**

Section 1.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana that the following tax levies and tax rates for the several funds of the City have been determined to be necessary for the purpose of raising revenue to meet the necessary expense of the City of West Lafayette for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2005 and ending December 31, 2005.
