

**ORDINANCE NO. 31-09**

AN ORDINANCE LIFTING THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE'S RESTRICTIONS ON THE IMPORT OF CERTAIN TYPES OF WASTE GENERATED OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE

WHEREAS, progress in technological development now allows for the generation of energy from certain types of waste; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Lafayette now possesses the technological capability to derive energy from certain types of waste, and this energy significantly defrays the City's costs in purchasing electricity; and

WHEREAS, the ordinances of the City of West Lafayette currently require that the City of West Lafayette accept waste generated solely within the corporate limits of the City of West Lafayette; and

WHEREAS, it inures to the benefit of the City of West Lafayette to accept waste from any point of origin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE that:

**CHAPTER 30, Article 8, Section 5** of the West Lafayette City Code shall be AMENDED to read as follows:

Sec. 30.08.5. Licensed commercial or industrial waste hauling.

A person who is a licensed commercial or industrial waste hauler may discharge compatible pollutants and those incompatible pollutants within the limits of admissibility set out in article II to the wastewater treatment plant at a time and place and in such amounts as permitted by the board. The board shall not be required to accept any such discharge if it elects in given cases not to do so. Wastewater so received must be preceded with a manifest of constituents and concentrations for each truck load. ~~and must further have been generated within the corporate limits of the City of West Lafayette.~~
